Nominations must be in writing and comply with the organisation's registered rules, may be made at any time from 21 November 2025.

The nominee must be a member of the Branch Executive and they shall be nominated by another member of the Branch Executive. The nomination shall be accepted in writing by the Nominee. Elections for the positions shall be conducted by and from the members of the Branch Executive.

Nomination forms can be downloaded by visiting aec.gov.au/ieb and selecting the relevant election. Alternatively, additional nomination forms are available upon request from the Returning Officer.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify all eligibility criteria set out in the organisation's rules, including financial status and any other necessary qualifications, before submitting their nominations.

Nominations must be received by the Returning Officer no later than 4:00pm (Australian Central Daylight Time (ACDT)) on 28 November 2025, using the lodgement method(s) specified below.

How to lodge nominations

Nominations must be submitted using one of the following methods:

By email: A fully completed nomination form, including all necessary signatures, may be scanned and emailed to IEBNominations@aec.gov.au.

PLEASE NOTE:

1.1 Nomination forms may be submitted as PDF files, with each candidate's form in a separate PDF.

1.2 When sending nominations via email, please use the subject line as:

"ASDB7 – E2025/54 – Nomination [Name of candidate]"

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON EMAILS:

1.3 Emails that appear to be spam may be blocked. It is the sender's responsibility to ensure their nomination email is delivered to the returning officer before the deadline.

1.4 Emails and attachments must not exceed 6 MB in total size.

After nominations close and acknowledgment

After nominations close, all submissions will be reviewed to ensure they meet eligibility criteria and comply with the organisation's rules. If any issues are identified, the returning officer will notify the relevant candidates and provide a specific timeframe to remedy their nomination.

Candidates will be informed of the outcome of these eligibility checks when the nominations accepted report is issued.

You will receive an acknowledgment email confirming receipt of your nomination. Please note that this acknowledgment may be sent before nominations close.

Voting period

If a ballot is required, it will open on 4 December 2025 and close at 12:00 noon (Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT)) on 9 January 2026.

Scrutineers

Candidates may appoint any member of the Union to act as a scrutineer on behalf of the candidate. The appointment period for scrutineers closes at 12:00 noon AEDT on 9 January 2026. A form is available from the returning officer for the purposes of appointing scrutineers.
